Begin at the latest starting from the seventh school year with the future planning (vocational training, but also housing situation).	<input type="checkbox"/>
In case of uncertainty as how to enter the career development process, it is worthwhile to register early for a (...) career counseling. Special schools often have their own counseling centers.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Get to know occupations and training paths; Collect ideas from the internet (...).	<input type="checkbox"/>
Take a closer look at strengths and weaknesses, if necessary together with a familiar and sympathetic teacher or as part of a "circle of support".	<input type="checkbox"/>
Attention: weaknesses can also be temporary! Young people with disabilities run the risk of being "draped".	<input type="checkbox"/>
Compare your own strengths and interests with the requirements of the occupations and training pathways	<input type="checkbox"/>
Take a closer look at interesting occupations, e.g. in a taster internship in day care centers and workshops or in companies of the first job market.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Decide together (...) for a training location, arrange a trial period with the training provider and sign up for satisfaction.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Clarify alternatives, if the training place does not work right away: extended (special) school, pre-employment offers, another job in the same occupational field, etc.).	<input type="checkbox"/>
In case of rejection of a vocational measure clarify alternatives: e.g. request independent projects (..) or a sympathetic company for a work experience.	<input type="checkbox"/>
